

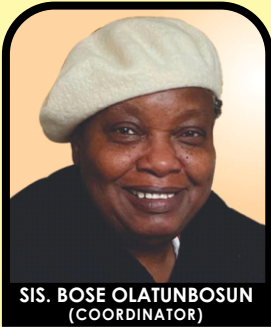

# Governed by GOD'S Will

The word “will” could be defined in various ways. It could be a documented piece from a man or woman on how he or she desires his property to be shared amongst his or her family. It is also the ability to do all that one pleases which could also mean “free will”.

God is so gracious that He didn't create us as robots and remote controls us whenever He pleases but chose to make us in His express image to think and act just like Him. Whenever we fail to think, see and act like Him, we malfunction.

If the LORD does not build the house, it is useless for the builders to work on it. If the LORD does not protect a city, it is useless for the guard to stay alert. It is useless to work hard for the food you eat by getting up early and going to bed late. The LORD gives food to those he loves while they sleep. (Psalm 127: 1-2).

Who is he that saith, and it cometh to pass, when the Lord commandeth it not? (Lamentation 3:37).

- **GOD'S WILL:** This is simply His desire or intentions concerning a person, thing or situation. The whole world is subject to God's desires. Just like the fish cannot live successfully outside the “water world”, nobody goes against His Will and succeeds because He is the beginning and the end of time.

God's Will for man is a guide to lead man into his ordained place of destiny or purpose for life.

- **Greater Prayer of all Time - Luke 22: 42:** "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done."

- **GOD SPEAKS ALWAYS – Isaiah 30:21:** Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way; walk in it."

- **Exodus 25:1- 40:** See that you make them according to the pattern shown you on the mountain.

- **WHY JESUS SUCCEEDED:** Jesus' earthly ministry was a huge success because he enveloped himself in the Will of His father.

*Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. (John 5:19)*

- **THE REASON BEHIND MOSES' FAILURE:** The great leader of the Israelites couldn't make it to the Promised Land simply because he rebelled against God's Will. At every point of our lives God's Will is ever present but if we chose to go against it, the consequence is never pleasant.

- **Mourning & Complaint Complicates Things – 1Samuel 30:8:** “*and David asked the LORD: “Should I pursue these raiders? Will I overtake them?” The LORD replied to him, “Pursue them, for you will certainly overtake them and rescue the people.”*”

I find it astonishing that God didn't utter a word when the King and his men were crying and wailing. Not even “it's going to be alright please stop crying”. But as soon as David posed the question, God responded without delay. God only responds to a heart-felt prayer not wailing, crying and complaint.

*'Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know. (Jeremiah 33:3)*

- **Bountiful Harvesting in Famine - Genesis 26:12-33:** And there was a famine in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar. And the LORD appeared unto him, and said, Go not down into Egypt; dwell in the land which I shall tell thee of: Sojourn in this land, and I will be with thee, and will bless thee; for unto thee, and unto thy seed, I will give all these countries, and I will perform the oath which I swear unto Abraham thy father; And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed. (Genesis 26: 1-4).

The story would have been different if Isaac had focussed more on the famine besieging the land at the time and ignored God's instruction but He obeyed and prospered even when the economy of the nation was in a very dire situation.

It is good to look at things logically but the place of God must never be disregarded. He has the final say in all matters no matter how little or insignificant.

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come,

**Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.** (Matthew 6: 6-10)
